Advanced Class Detailed Agenda

Most of the class time will be spent polishing your work pieces. We recommend bringing various parts such as cavities, cores, round work, and core pins to last for 3 days of polishing. Work pieces with rough surface finishes are ideal.

Class Day 1

- Introductory presentation on advanced mold polishing concepts.
- Hands on training flat surface polishing up to A3, A2, and A1 finishes (workpiece provided by Gesswein).
- Develop customized polishing plans for your work pieces with instructor and begin polishing!

Class Day 2

- Continue polishing your work pieces.
- 'Make your own tools' training. Create customized polishing tools for your work pieces.
- Overview of advanced technology for tool rooms such as laser welders, TIG welders, and electropolishing machines. Hands-on training is optional.

Class Day 3

- Continue polishing your work pieces.
- Polishing core pins training.
- Leave around lunchtime to catch a flight or keep training until 5pm.
